Key Teaching Points

Discuss springtime and the behaviour of newborn lambs. Explain why the baby lamb's tail was wagging so fast.

Key Questions

Why was the baby lamb calling to its mother? (*Literal*)
Why was the baby lamb happy in the spring? (*Inferential*)

Word Study

Say these words slowly: *Baby, hungry, happy.*List more words with the same letter and final sound, e.g. *Sally, daisy.*Discuss the capital letter *H* in the word *Here* on page 8.
