said Tiger.

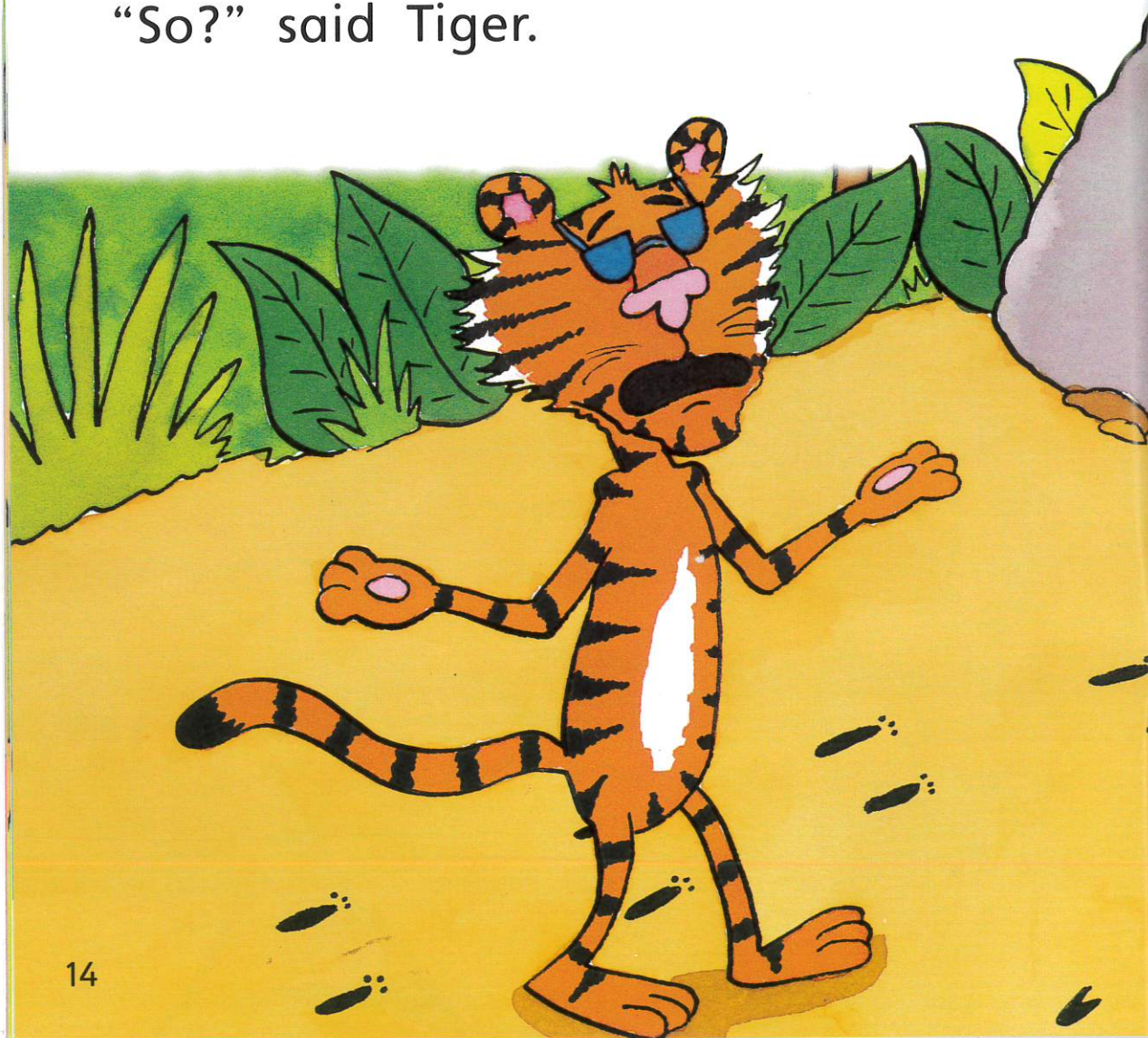
“Yes, why not?” said Fox,
