BEFORE READING

Talk together

- Look at the cover and read the title together. Ask: *What sort of faces are the children making?*
- Look at page 1 and explain the game the family are playing.
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

About the words in this book

- Your child should be able to sound out and blend some words, which may include:

Dad Mum sad Biff

- Some words may be more challenging. Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.

frightened hungry
Chip Kipper



DURING READING

Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the words:

- Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
- Model how to sound out and blend new words if necessary.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.

AFTER READING

- Look back at the pictures and find the card that each member of the family is holding.
- Read the word and ask your child to find it in the sentence.
- Take it in turns to choose a word and make the face for the other person to guess.
- Find Kipper in each picture and ask your child to describe what he is doing and explain why.
