



BEFORE READING Talk together

- Look at the cover and read the title together. Ask: What sort of faces are the children making?
- Look at page I and explain the game the family are playing.
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.


DURING READING

Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the words:

- Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
- Model how to sound out and blend new words if necessary.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.

AFTER READING

- Look back at the pictures and find the card that each member of the family is holding.
- Read the word and ask your child to find it in the sentence.
- Take it in turns to choose a word and make the face for the other person to guess.
