Key Teaching Points

Discuss why the back wheel of Josh's scooter came off.

Talk about the big boy, Max. Consider how Josh and Lily knew him and why he let Josh ride his scooter.

Key Questions

What happened to Josh's scooter? (Literal)

Why did Max help Josh to ride his big scooter in the skate bowl? (Inferential)

Word Study

Reinforce cross-checking meaning (picture) with visual (letter) cues.

Use PM Alphabet Blends sc and sk to reinforce the initial sound in scooter and skate.

Discuss the purpose of the exclamation marks in this story.



is coming off."


"Oh, no!" said Josh.

"Your scooter is too big for me," said Josh.




"I will help you,"
