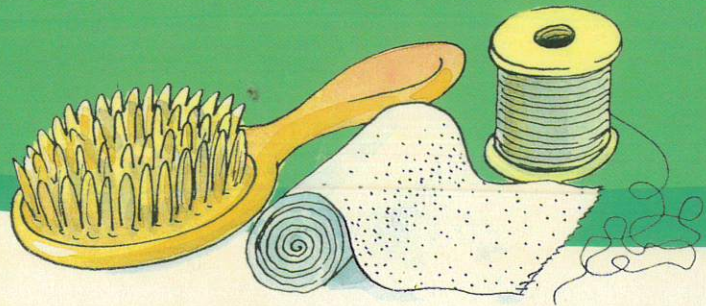

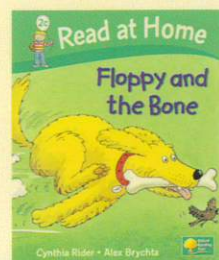


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### Level 2: Starting to Read

- know some initial letter sounds



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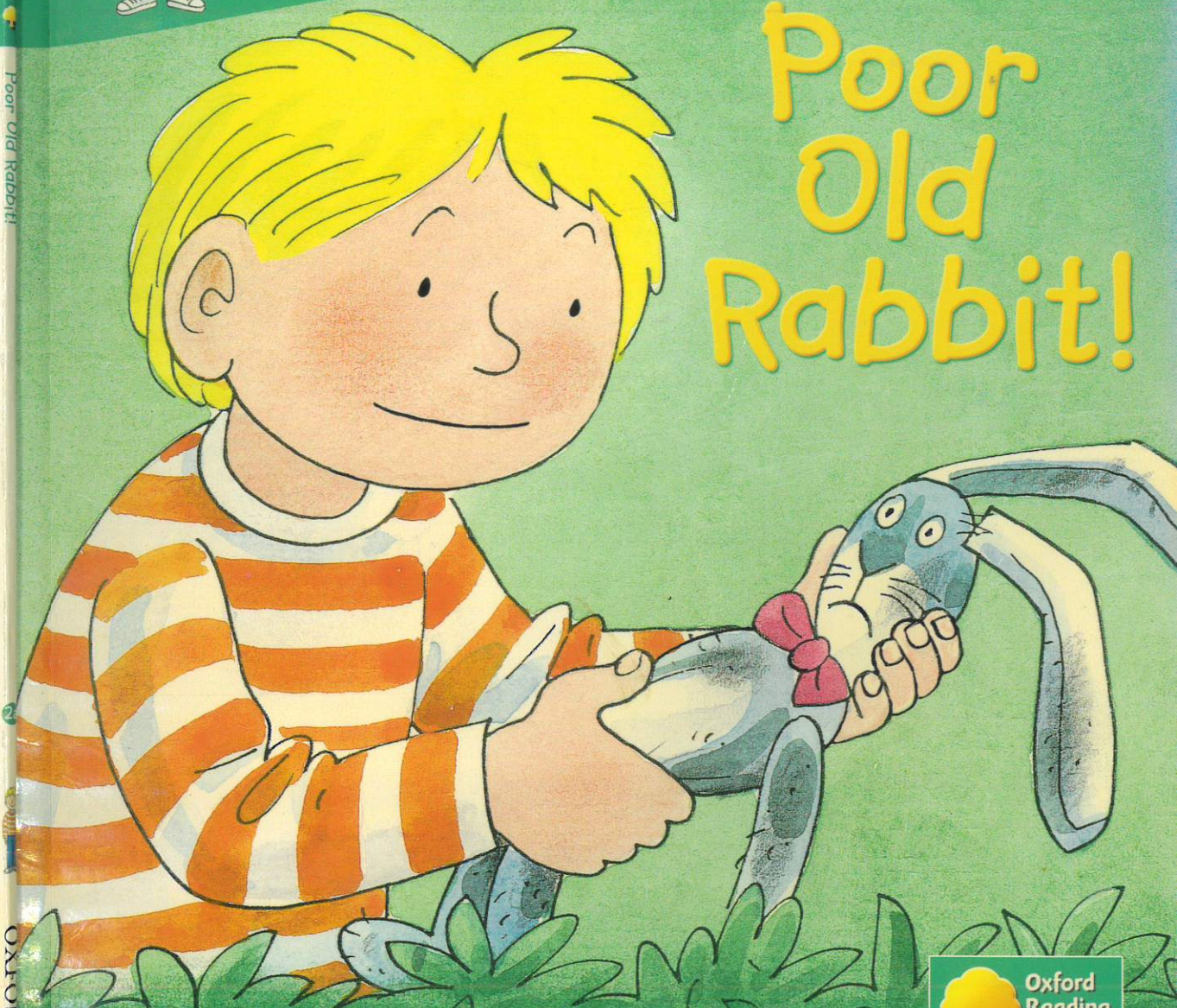

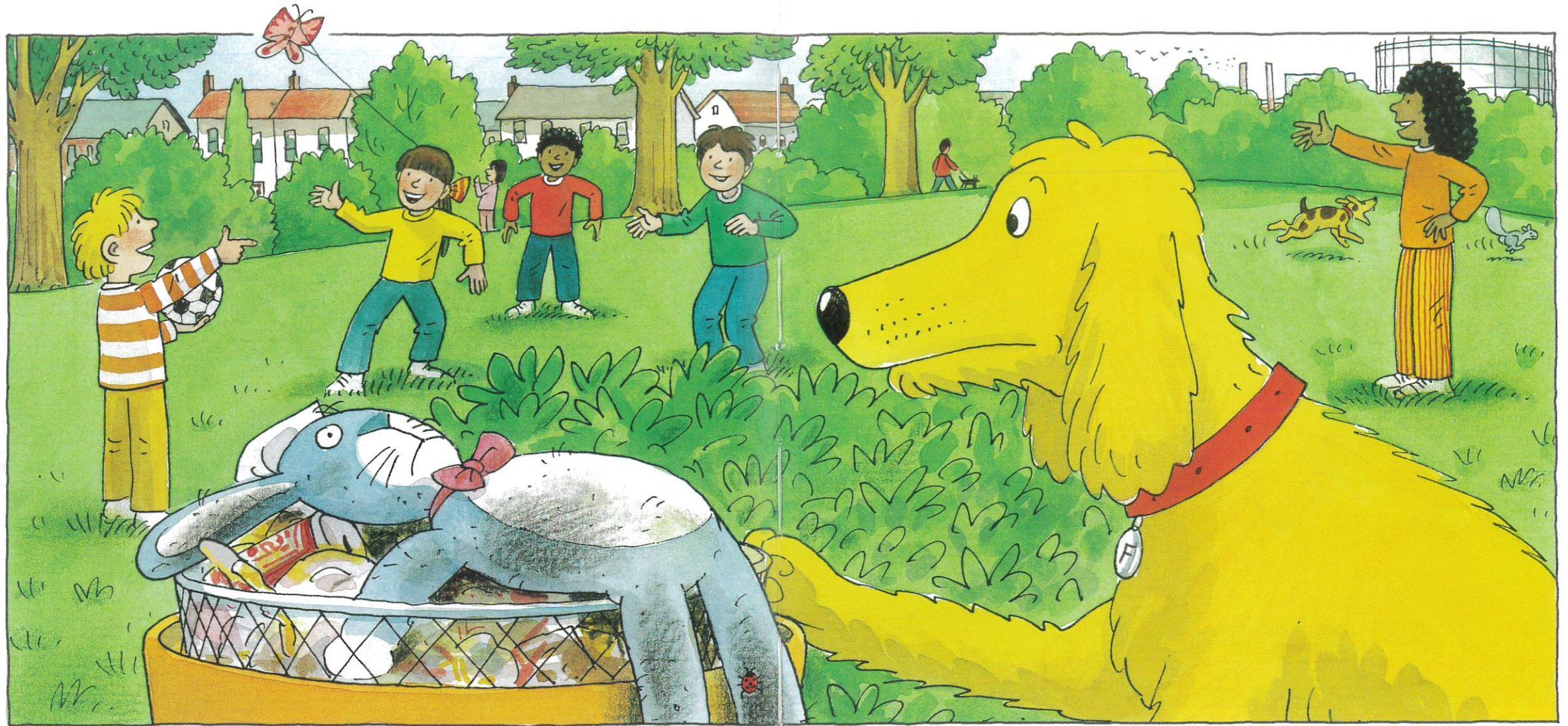






Floppy saw a toy rabbit.

“Nobody wants it.”



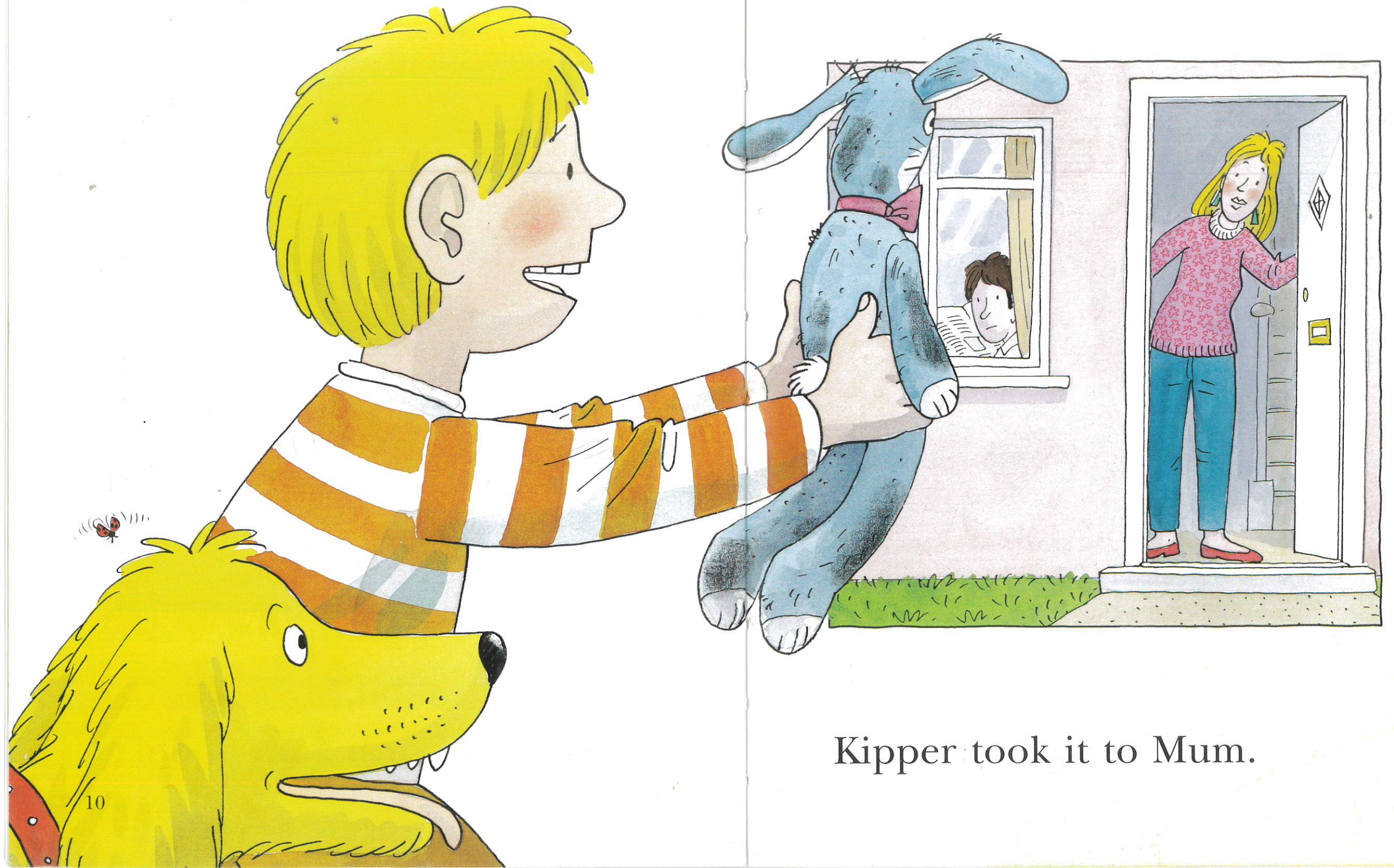


Floppy took it to Kipper.

Chip and Wilma mended it.



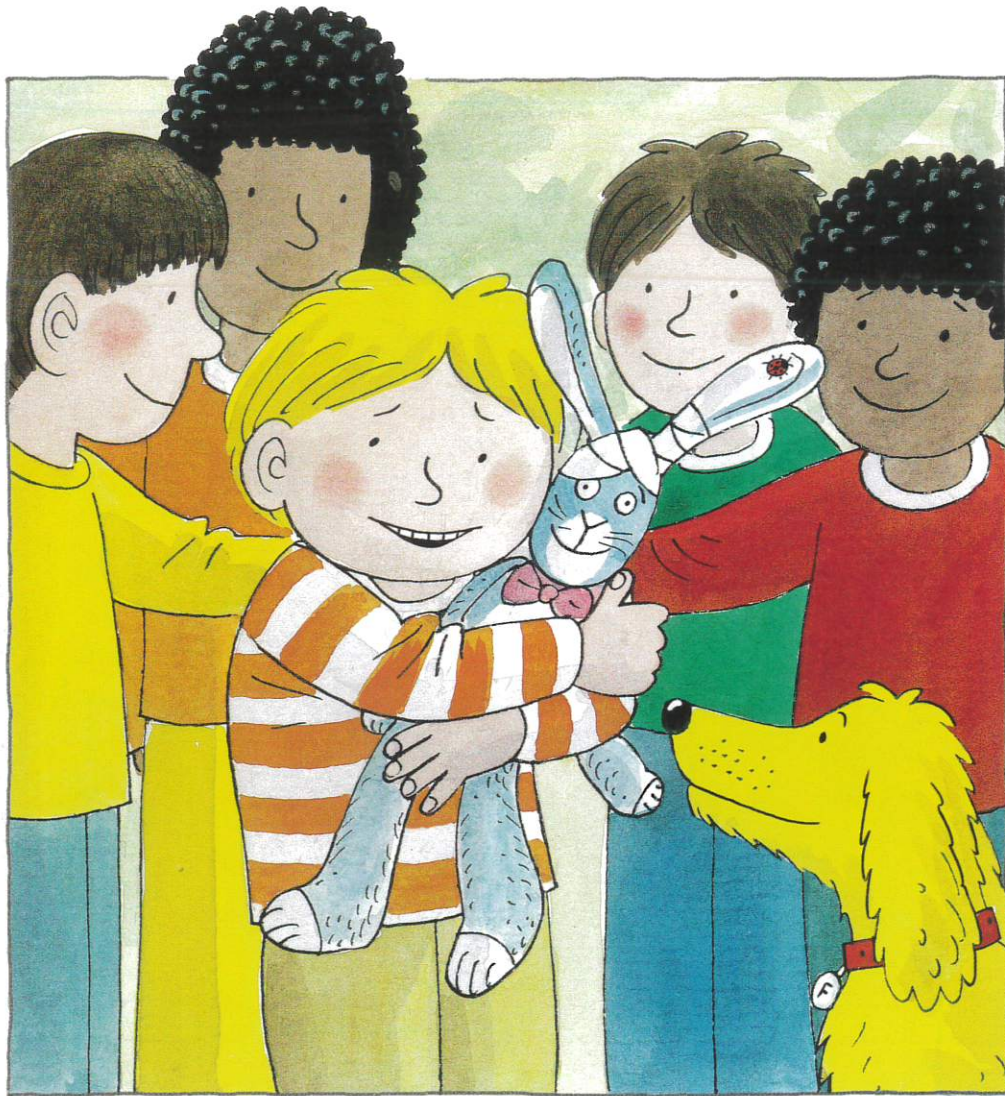


Everybody wanted it now.



Oh no!





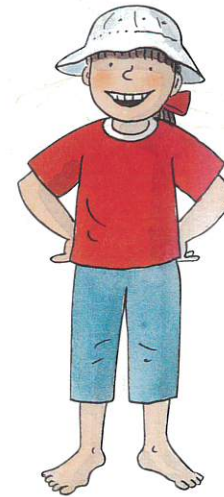
“Poor old rabbit,”
